This Week's Scripture

Psalm 9

To the choirmaster: according to Muth-labben. A Psalm of David.

- ¹ I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds.
- ² I will be glad and exult in you;
 - I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.
- ³ When my enemies turn back, they stumble and perish before your presence.
- ⁴ For you have maintained my just cause; you have sat on the throne, giving righteous judgment.
- ⁵ You have rebuked the nations; you have made the wicked perish; you have blotted out their name forever and ever.
- ⁶ The enemy came to an end in everlasting ruins; their cities you rooted out;

the very memory of them has perished.

- ⁷ But the Lord sits enthroned forever;
 - he has established his throne for justice,
- 8 and he judges the world with righteousness; he judges the peoples with uprightness.
- ⁹ The Lord is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.
- ¹⁰ And those who know your name put their trust in you, for you, O Lord, have not forsaken those who seek you.
- ¹¹ Sing praises to the Lord, who sits enthroned in Zion! Tell among the peoples his deeds!
- 12 For he who avenges blood is mindful of them; he does not forget the cry of the afflicted.
- ¹³ Be gracious to me. O Lord!

See my affliction from those who hate me, O you who lift me up from the gates of death,

 $^{\rm 14}$ that I may recount all your praises,

that in the gates of the daughter of Zion

I may rejoice in your salvation.

- ¹⁵ The nations have sunk in the pit that they made; in the net that they hid, their own foot has been caught.
- ¹⁶ The Lord has made himself known; he has executed judgment; the wicked are snared in the work of their own hands. Higgaion. *Selah*
- $^{\rm 17}$ The wicked shall return to Sheol,

all the nations that forget God.

- ¹⁸ For the needy shall not always be forgotten, and the hope of the poor shall not perish forever.
- ¹⁹ Arise, O Lord! Let not man prevail;

let the nations be judged before you!

²⁰ Put them in fear, O Lord!




Prayer of Commitment
