If you are saying this prayer for the first time today, please share with a church leader up front, or let one of the pastors know.

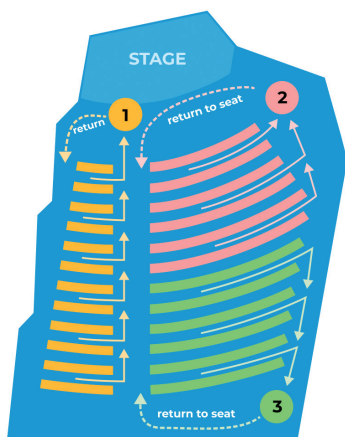
Prayer of Commitment

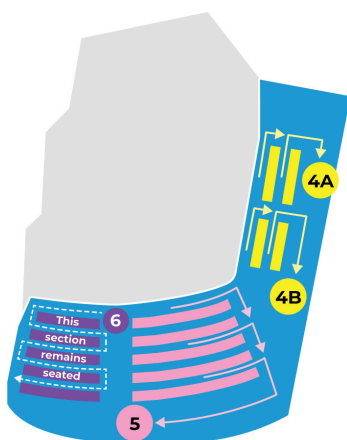
