## This Week's Scripture

### Exodus 21-23 (selections)

<sup>21:1</sup> “Now these are the rules that you shall set before them.

<sup>12</sup> “Whoever strikes a man so that he dies shall be put to death.

<sup>13</sup> But if he did not lie in wait for him, but God let him fall into his hand, then I will appoint for you a place to which he may flee.

<sup>14</sup> But if a man willfully attacks another to kill him by cunning, you shall take him from my altar, that he may die.

<sup>15</sup> “Whoever strikes his father or his mother shall be put to death. <sup>16</sup> “Whoever steals a man and sells him, and anyone found in possession of him, shall be put to death.

<sup>22</sup> “When men strive together and hit a pregnant woman, so that her children come out, but there is no harm, the one who hit her shall surely be fined, as the woman's husband shall impose on him, and he shall pay as the judges determine. <sup>23</sup> But if there is harm, then you shall pay life for life, <sup>24</sup> eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, <sup>25</sup> burn for burn, wound for wound, stripe for stripe.

<sup>28</sup> “When an ox gores a man or a woman to death, the ox shall be stoned, and its flesh shall not be eaten, but the owner of the ox shall not be liable. <sup>29</sup> But if the ox has been accustomed to gore in the past, and its owner has been warned but has not kept it in, and it kills a man or a woman, the ox shall be stoned, and its owner also shall be put to death.

<sup>33</sup> “When a man opens a pit, or when a man digs a pit and does not cover it, and an ox or a donkey falls into it, <sup>34</sup> the owner of the pit shall make restoration. He shall give money to its owner, and the dead beast shall be his.

<sup>22:21</sup> “You shall not wrong a sojourner or oppress him, for you were sojourners in the land of Egypt. <sup>22</sup> You shall not mistreat any widow or fatherless child. <sup>23</sup> If you do mistreat them, and they cry out to me, I will surely hear their cry, <sup>24</sup> and my wrath will burn, and I will kill you with the sword, and your wives shall become widows and your children fatherless.

<sup>23:19</sup> “The best of the firstfruits of your ground you shall bring into the house of the LORD your God. “You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk.

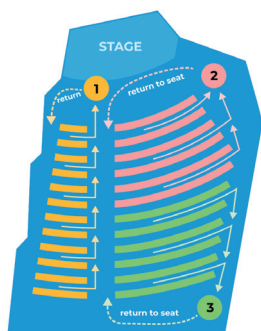

### Prayer of Commitment

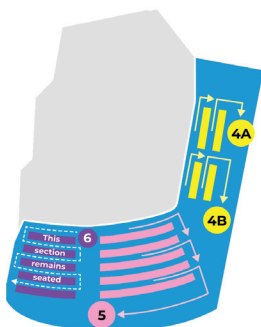
